THE POST CANE

The famous Post cane which is given by the Boston Post, to be kept by the oldest citizen in Walpole until his death, and then passed on to the next oldest in line, will shortly be presented by Mr. Arthur Maguire, chairman of the Board of Selectmen to Mr. Porter Boyden of Common street, who has attained the age of 91 years.

The cane was made by the J. F. Bradley Company of New York, and is of Congo Ivory with a 14 carat gold head.

It was last in possession of Mr. Henry Achorn who lived at the corner of Union and Pleasant streets.
